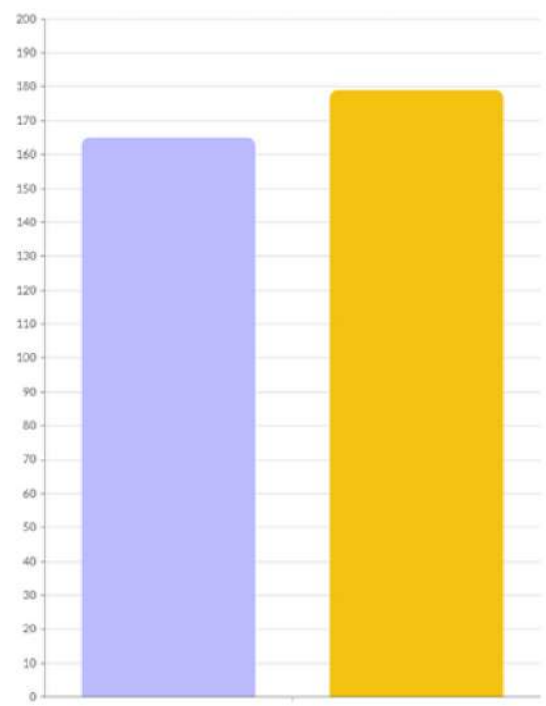

SCHOOL RE-DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

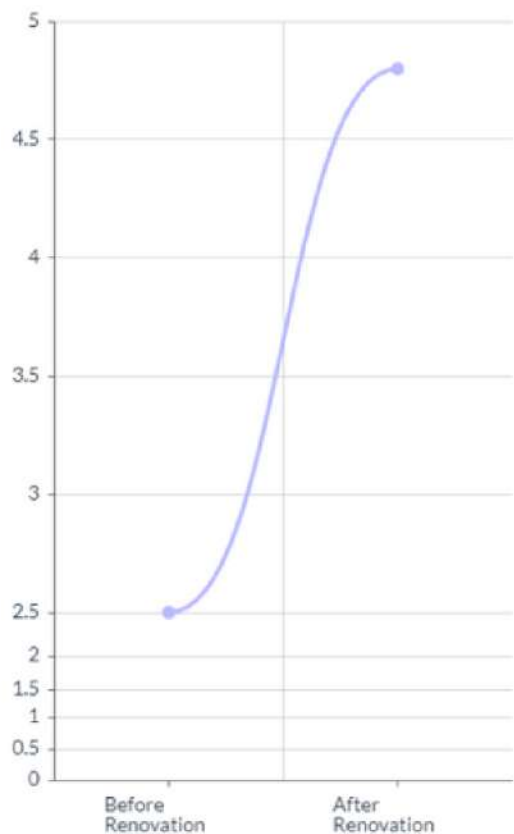
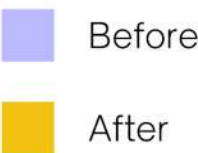

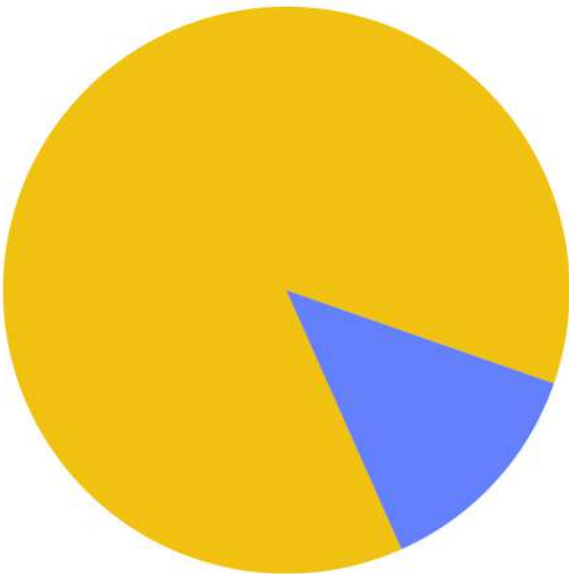




VILLAGE LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM

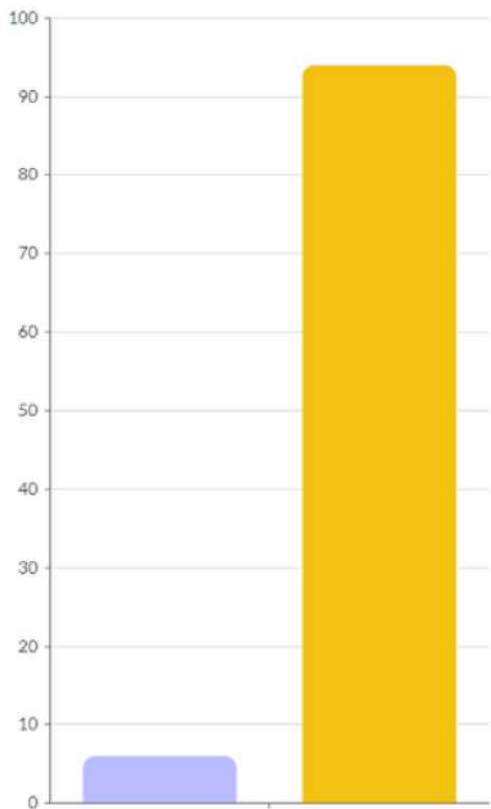




VETERINARY CAMPS

In the context of the Veterinary Camp program, Shruti Foundation conducted an assessment to evaluate its impact on livestock health and the livelihoods of livestock owners in the village. The assessment encompassed three key areas:

- **Impact on Livestock Health:** The survey aimed to determine whether the Veterinary Camp program contributed to an improvement in the overall health and well-being of livestock in the village, as observed by the community members. It also sought to assess whether there was a noticeable reduction in common livestock health issues among animals owned by those who attended the camps.
- **Access to Veterinary Care:** The assessment inquired about whether the program facilitated easier access to veterinary care services for livestock owners in the village. It aimed to identify instances where livestock owners who were previously unable to access veterinary care had benefited from the camps.
- **Overall Impact:** The survey sought to gather perspectives on the overall impact of the Veterinary Camp program from the viewpoint of the community. It aimed to understand whether the program had positively influenced the overall health and well-being of livestock and, consequently, the livelihoods of livestock owners in the village.

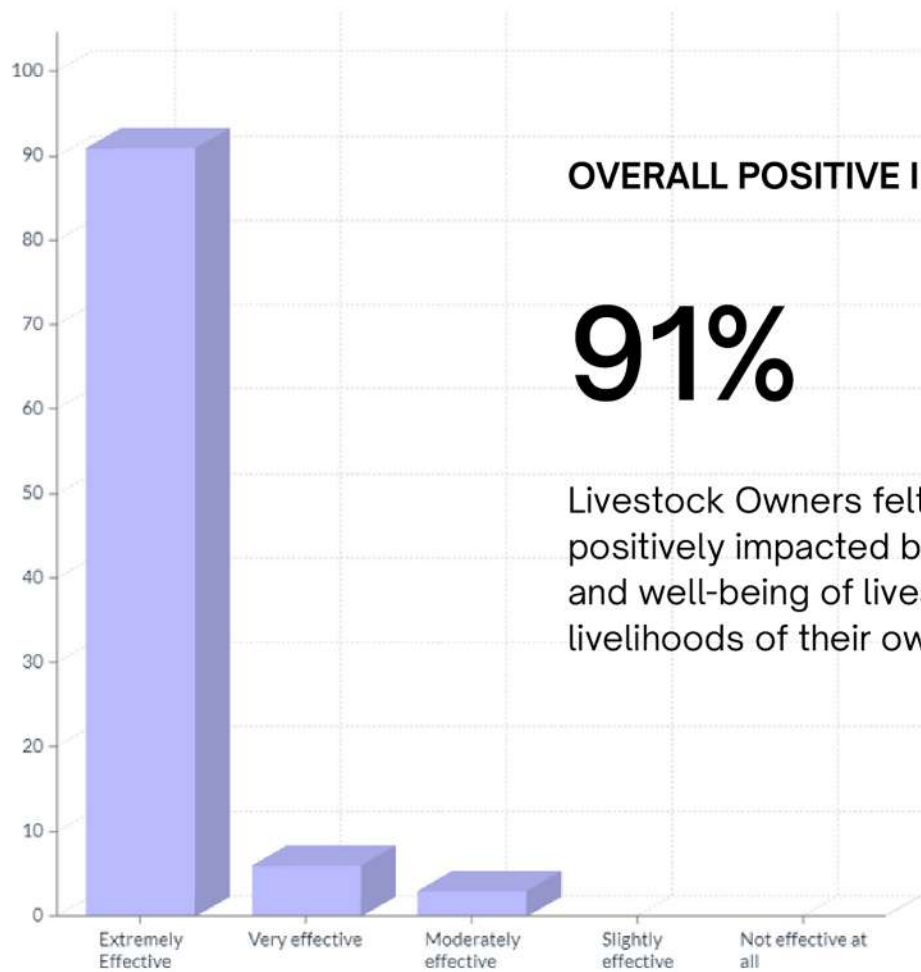

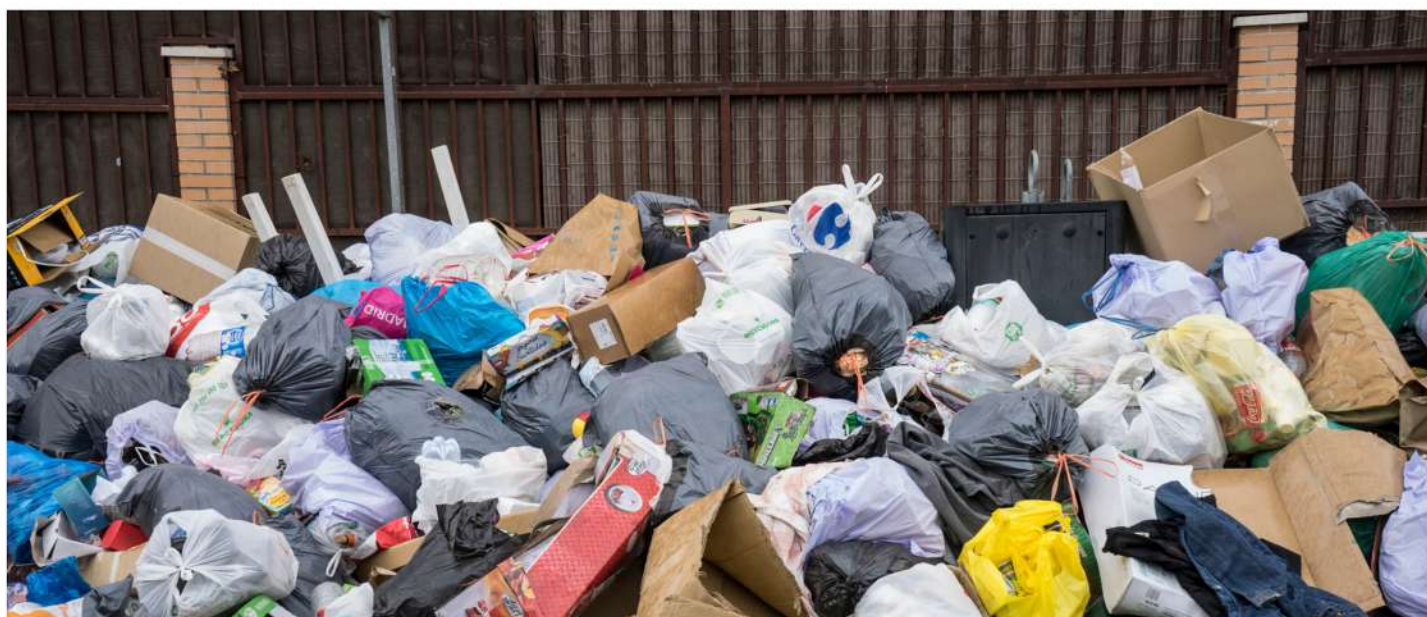

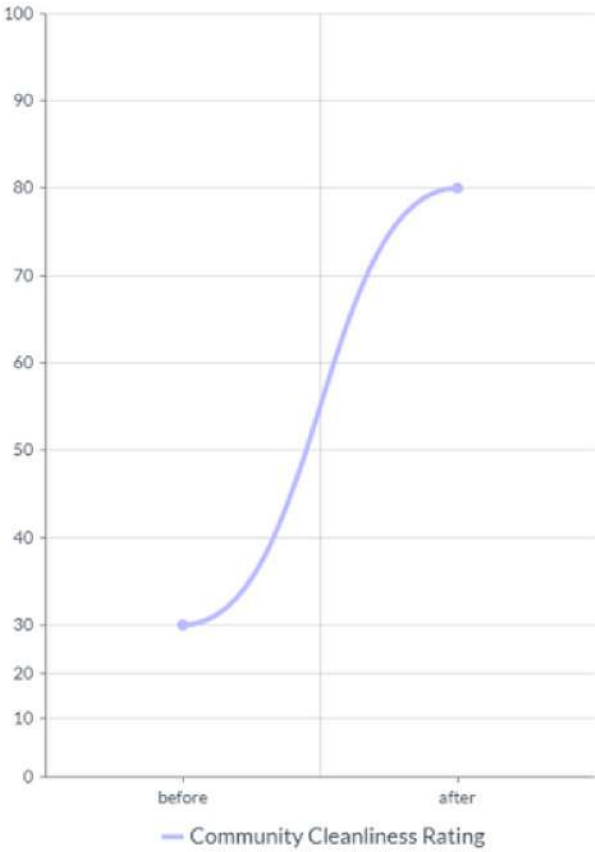


SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

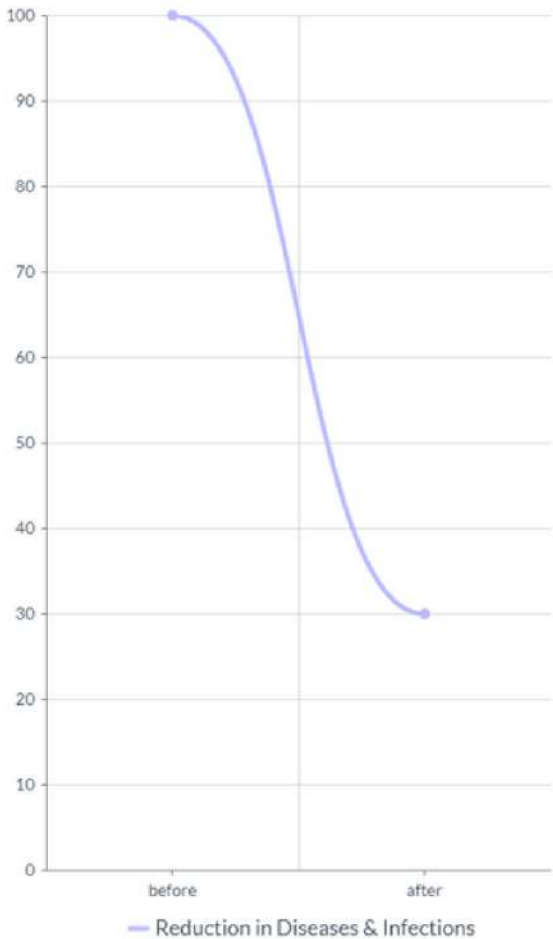

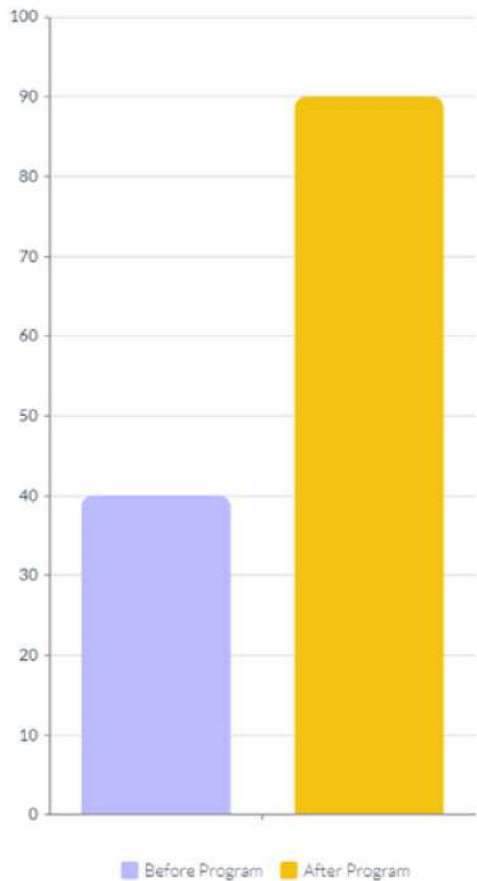
SPINE SURGERY, REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION SURGERIES

Lakshmi Machine Works Ltd collaborates with leading hospitals and rehabilitation centres in Coimbatore to support.

- Surgery for spine injury & subsequent rehabilitation.
- Plastic surgery, Hand reconstructive surgery, reconstructive microsurgery & Burns.

During the rehabilitation process, the patients are supported in vocational skill development to help them in establishing alternative means of income generation to offset the loss of employment. Special equipment such as wheelchairs (motorized/manual), crutches, standing frames etc. are provided to the patients based on the requirements. In total 137 individuals were supported through the CSR funds to avail the necessary medical treatment and rehabilitation.





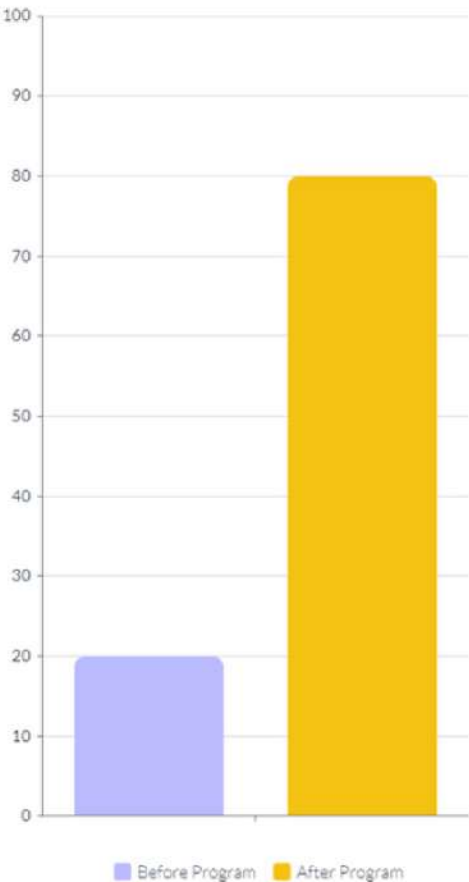

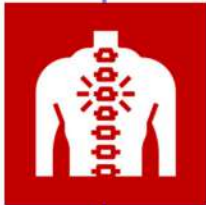

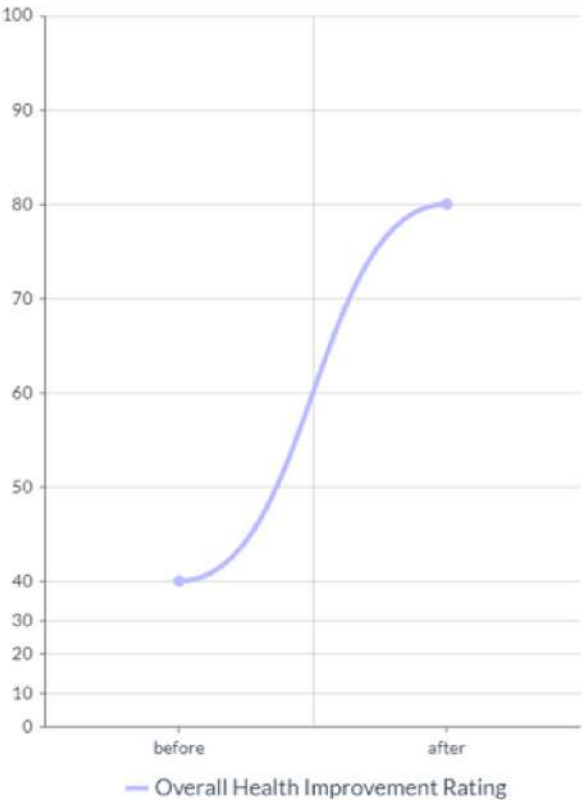
DIABETES INTERVENTION PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN

Diabetes is a chronic disease that occurs either when the pancreas does not produce enough insulin or when the body cannot effectively use the insulin it produces. Prevalence has risen more rapidly in low- and middle-income countries than in high-income countries. Diabetes is a significant cause of blindness, kidney failure, heart attacks, stroke and lower limb amputation.

Type 1 diabetes is when the immune system destroys insulin-making cells in the pancreas. These are called beta cells. The condition is usually diagnosed in children and young people and is also called juvenile diabetes. It requires daily administration of insulin to maintain blood glucose levels.

LMW has partnered with Idhayangal Charitable Trust to support the treatment of Type 1 diabetes among children from economically weaker families in and around Coimbatore District. The beneficiaries under this project were supported by providing the insulin pen & cartridges, glucometers and necessary consumables to mitigate and maintain the blood glucose level. During 2022-23, thirty children were supported through this project.

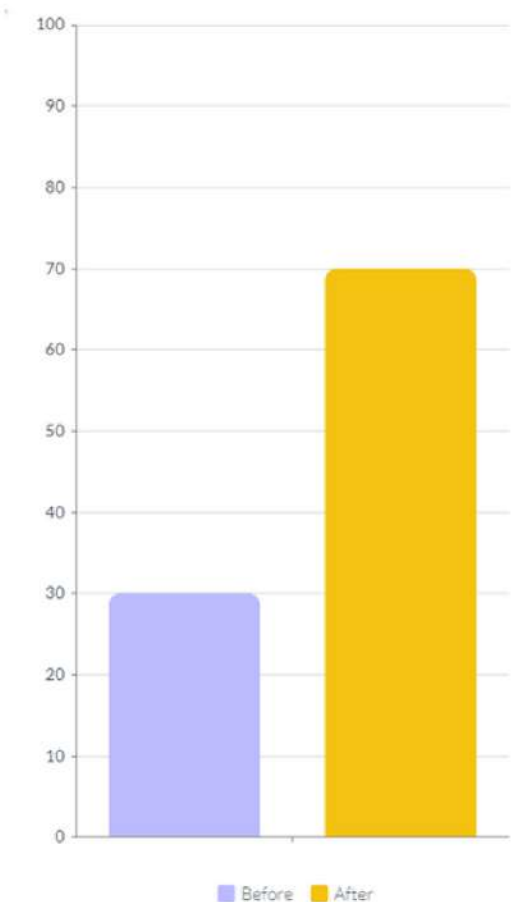

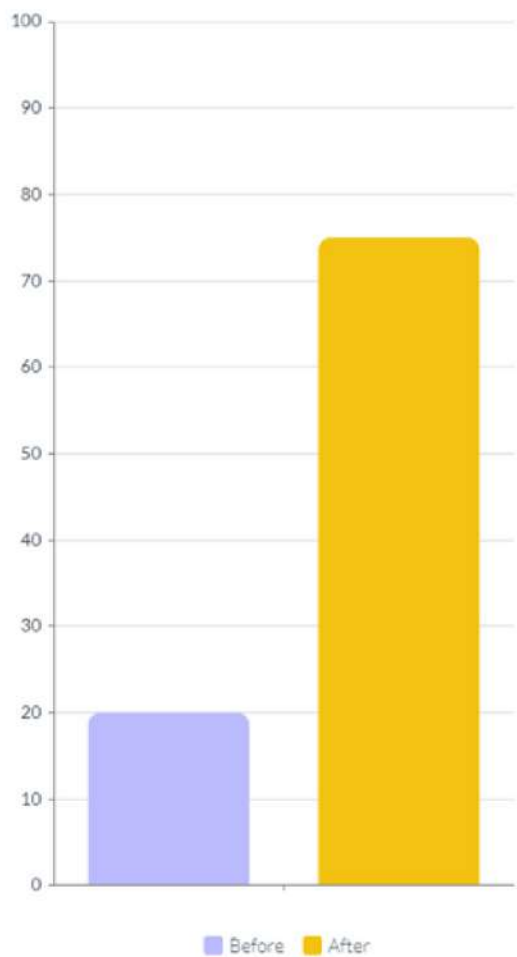

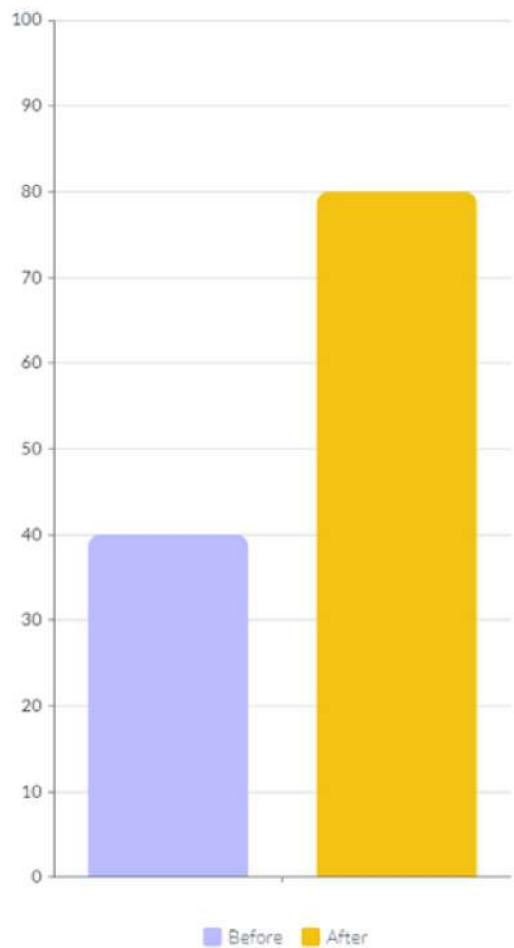

Data gathered from the survey highlights notable changes in the child's health post-treatment, including increased hemoglobin levels, improved blood sugar control, and overall health improvements.



According to the feedback collected, children received significant support from LMW regarding insulin and medical contrabands.

TREE PLANTING IN VILLAGES

Lakshmi Machine Works Ltd is committed to positively impacting the environment through tree planting. This initiative aims to restore natural habitats, reduce carbon emissions, and enhance biodiversity. In addition to contributing to the environmental sustainability of our planet, it also supports the social and economic development of those living in these areas.

LMW has partnered with the Mopperipalayam Town Panchayat in establishing 'Lakshmi Vanam' by planting 3000 saplings of indigenous tree species in Solla Kattupalayam village. Employees from LMW and volunteers from the village participated in the tree-planting event.
